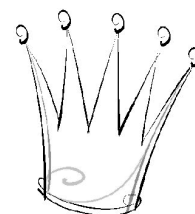

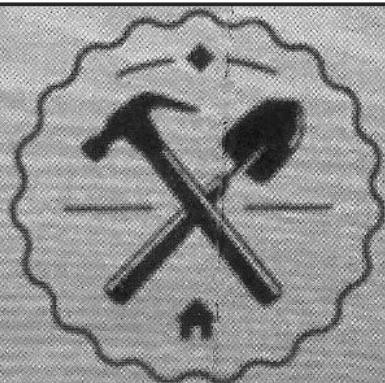

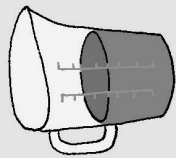

Make an edible pond

You will need:

- 500ml pack of lime jelly
- Sachet of blackcurrant jelly
- Sachet of gelatine
- Blue food colouring
- Dragon fruit or cooked tapioca
- Jelly worms, bugs or fish
- Green apple fruit bars
- Green grapes
- Chocolate frogs
- 1 litre clear bowl
- Measuring jugs
- Sieve
- Scissors

Follow packet instructions to mix each colour of jelly in a jug. Allow jelly to cool (but not set) before pouring it into the bowl to create a new layer. In your bowl, allow each new layer of jelly to set for an hour in the fridge before adding another layer.



LAYER FOUR

Half a pint of gelatine, add a few drops of blue food colouring

LAYER THREE

Remaining green jelly

LAYER TWO

Half the green jelly + two drops of blue food colouring

LAYER ONE

Make up the blackcurrant jelly, pour it into the bowl, and leave to set.

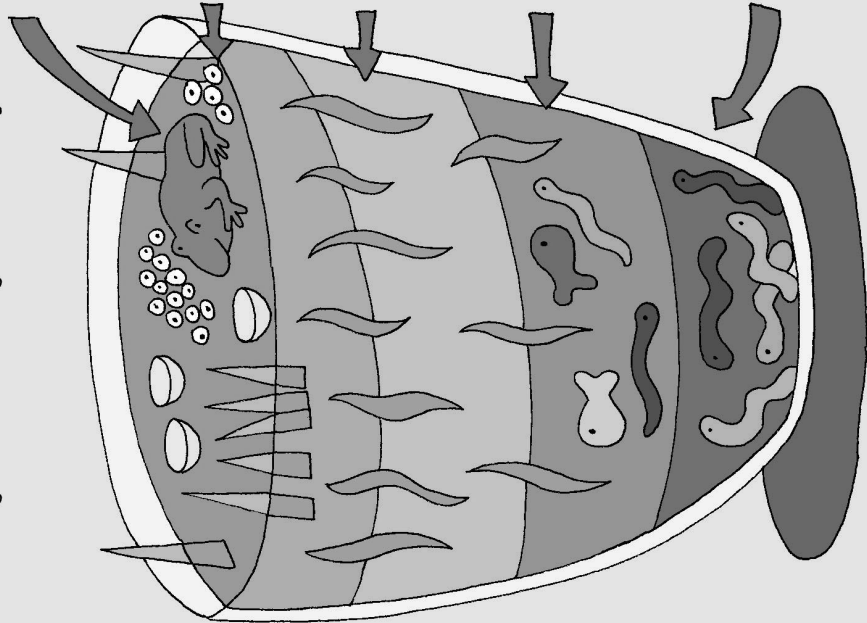
Add a chocolate frog near the spawn and enjoy!

A clump of chopped dragon fruit or tapioca (frogspawn) with some sliced green grapes (lily pads).

Stick the remaining reed shapes upright into the jelly

Another layer of worms or bugs and half of reed shapes cut from the apple fruit bar

A layer of jelly worms

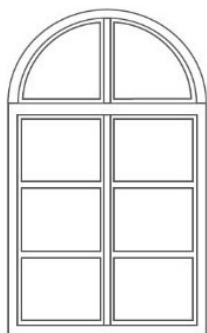

Tables and floor protected with large areas of plastic sheeting and an array of trays of plants, bags of compost and several sizes and types of hanging basket provided. Club members were seated classroom style to listen (and hopefully learn) the principles and art of planting and nurturing hanging baskets to be full of bloom in the summer.

The skill and art of this popular form of gardening was described by Carol Bailey, the clubs head gardener. From the choice of basket lining to optimise compost moisture and retention, to plant selection and positioning with clever and helpful tips much appreciated by the audience. Carol stressed the need to keep baskets well-watered all summer.

The purpose of the evening, other than the sharing of good gardening practice, was to encourage club members to construct a number of completed baskets for inclusion in the Clubs annual plant sale (June 8th 2019) along with some for personal display. This practical work was enthusiastically carried out by many of the members, with help from Carol, encouraging the sharing of ideas. This event was new to the club and clearly enjoyed by all and, in the future, may include more practical aspects of gardening.

This month's competition, to produce a Spring Botanical Display from your garden, was reasonably entered, but could have been better, Once again Hilde Crapnell took the honours with a beautiful display, principally of late flowering bulbs.

Club chairman, Glynis Wash, thanked Carol for her excellent description, demonstration and provision of such a variety of plants. Congratulations were also due to the members for their efforts on the evening. Glynis also thanked those members who helped to set up before and cleared away after, so quickly and efficiently.

The Cockfield Benefice

In June we celebrate our birthday. Well, the church does, as Pentecost is often regarded as the birthday of the Christian church, and the start of the church's mission to the world. So what does it mean? In the Acts of the Apostles, the book that follows the four gospels in the New Testament in the bible, we read an account of what happened to the disciples after Jesus had ascended into heaven following his resurrection from the dead.

Pentecost happens 50 days after Easter (the name comes from the Greek *pentekoste*, 'fiftieth'). It is a celebration of the day that the Holy Spirit, the third part of the Trinity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit came upon the disciples of Jesus. It sounded like a very strong wind, and it looked like tongues of fire. And then the disciples found themselves speaking in foreign languages, inspired by the Holy Spirit. People passing by at first thought that they must be drunk, but the disciple Peter told the crowd that the disciples were full of the Holy Spirit – not spirits of the alcoholic variety!

This year Pentecost falls on 9th June, and on 16th June we celebrate Trinity Sunday. Trinity is all about God as three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Many people find the Trinity confusing – even those of us who preach on it regularly!

All in all June is a great month for celebrating, for getting together and sharing food and fun. I hope to see you at our patronal service at St Peter's on 30th June at 10am, when we can celebrate the saint who I am calling 'the people's saint'!

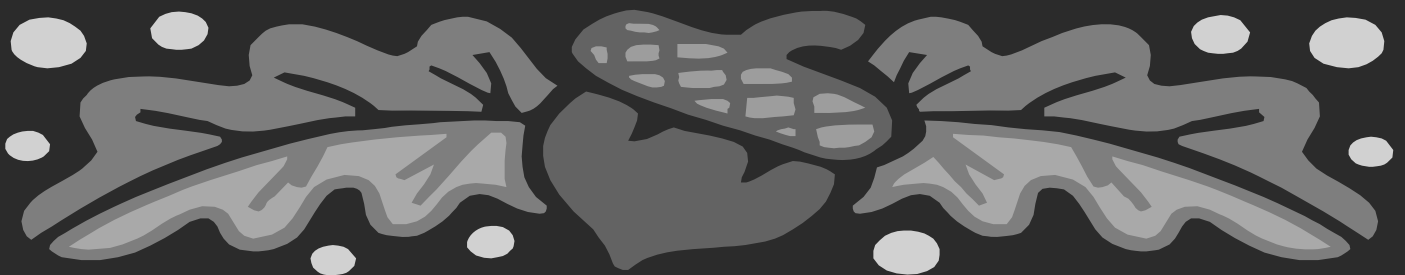

Elite cycle racing is coming to Gedding and Felsham on Monday 10th June, as the OVO Energy Women's Tour passes through our villages during stage one of the six stage race, on its way from Beccles to Stowmarket.

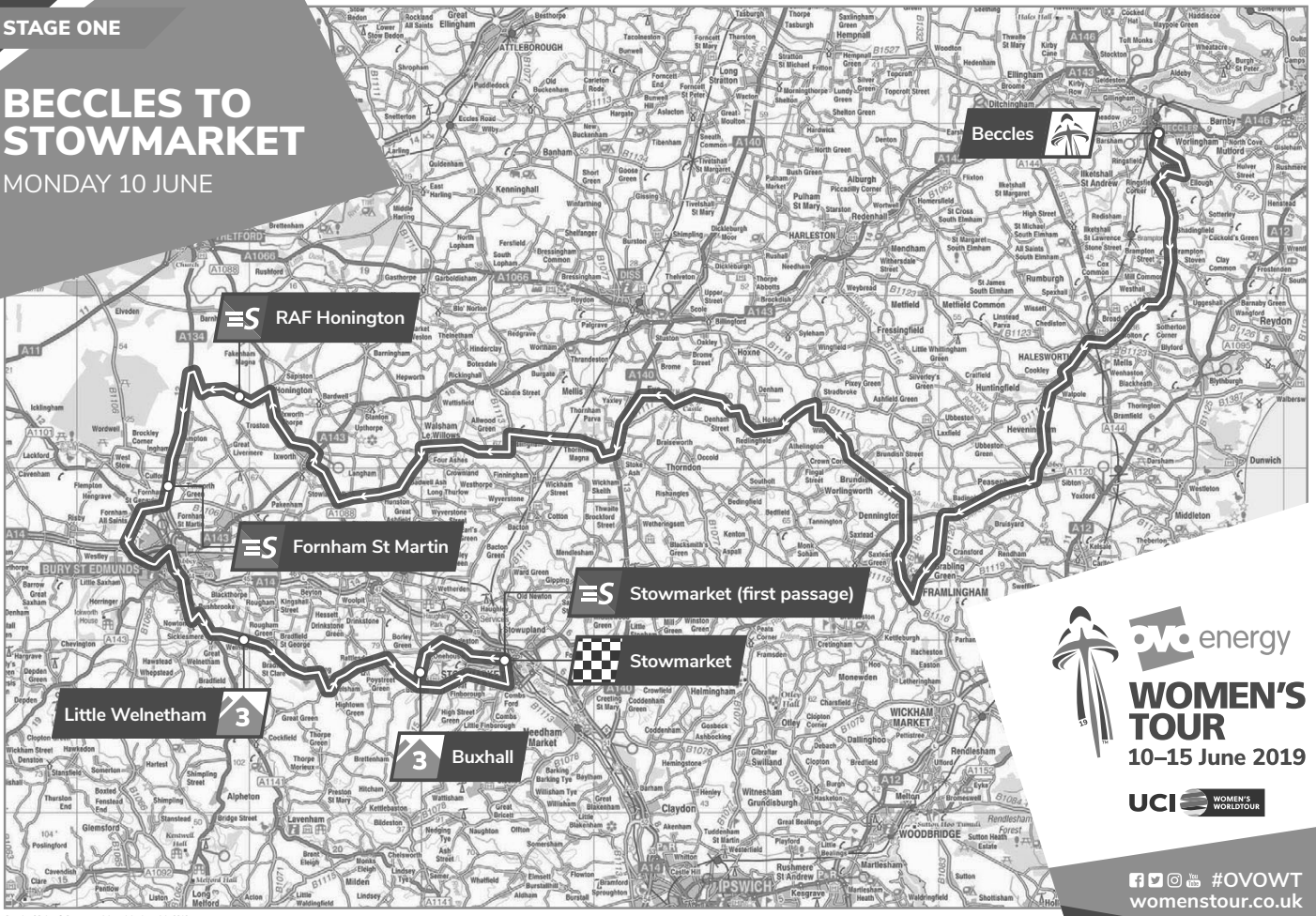
