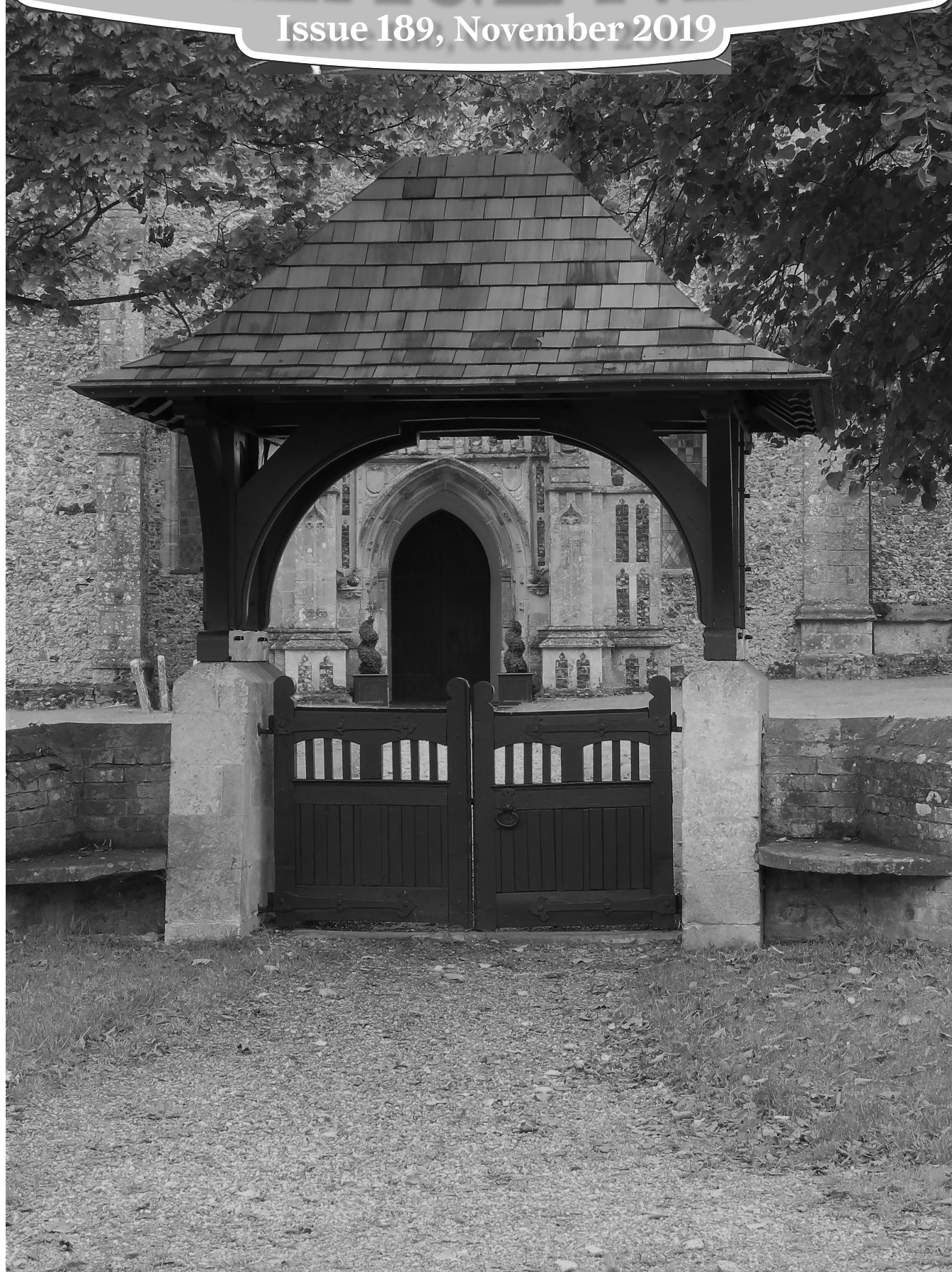

Please buy your tickets and return the stubs and money either to the Shop or to Beryl Meed opposite before the end of November.

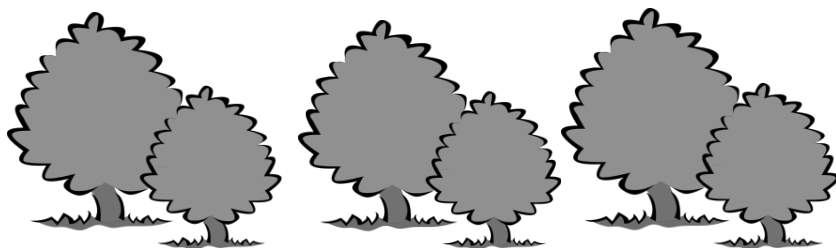

Recent thefts of power tools from vehicles in Suffolk

Police are investigating a series of thefts from motor vehicles that took place across Suffolk over the weekend of Sat 5 October, the offenders were targeting vans for power-tools. Over this period around 40 incidents of theft from motor vehicles were reported in Suffolk and on the Suffolk/Essex border. The offenders have gained entry by drilling doors and windows to gain entry.

"The theft of these power tools will cause a great deal of distress, upheaval and inconvenience to those who have had their vehicles broken into – in the vast majority of these cases we are talking about the livelihoods of these victims being disrupted due to the actions of those responsible.

"We would remind tradesmen and van owners to check their vehicles are locked and windows are secure when leaving them unattended to help minimise the risk of being targeted by thieves. If possible, work equipment, expensive tools and any other valuables should also be removed and left in a secure location elsewhere. Keep note of the serial numbers of your tools, or engrave them to ensure they are identifiable as yours. Deter thieves by backing your van close to a wall when parking and ensure it is alarmed and parked either in a garage or a well-lit, public area."

If you are offered tools in suspicious circumstances, please do not buy them and let police know immediately via 101. You can also contact Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111.

Van owners are also advised to register their tools for free at www.immobilise.com by taking note of the serial numbers and models, and to use ultraviolet pen to (invisibly) mark their property, which increases the chances of having them returned to you in the event of being lost or stolen.

Van drivers should also consider the following measures to reduce the risk of being a victim of crime:

- Always lock all doors & shut windows, physically checking van doors are locked.
 - Park in a garage or secure area where possible.
 - Park with the doors against a wall.
 - If you park on your driveway consider installing motion activated CCTV.
 - Be particularly aware when unloading.
 - Remove tools from the van if possible.
 - To increase the security of tools, you can bolt either a cage or box to the base of the van which should be secured with a sturdy close shackle padlock to reduce and deter further incidents.
 - Setting an alarm or immobiliser will make it more difficult for the offender.
 - Consider upgrading locks/fitting additional protection.

This year's Christmas Tree Festival starts on 1st December so lets make this year's the best ever.

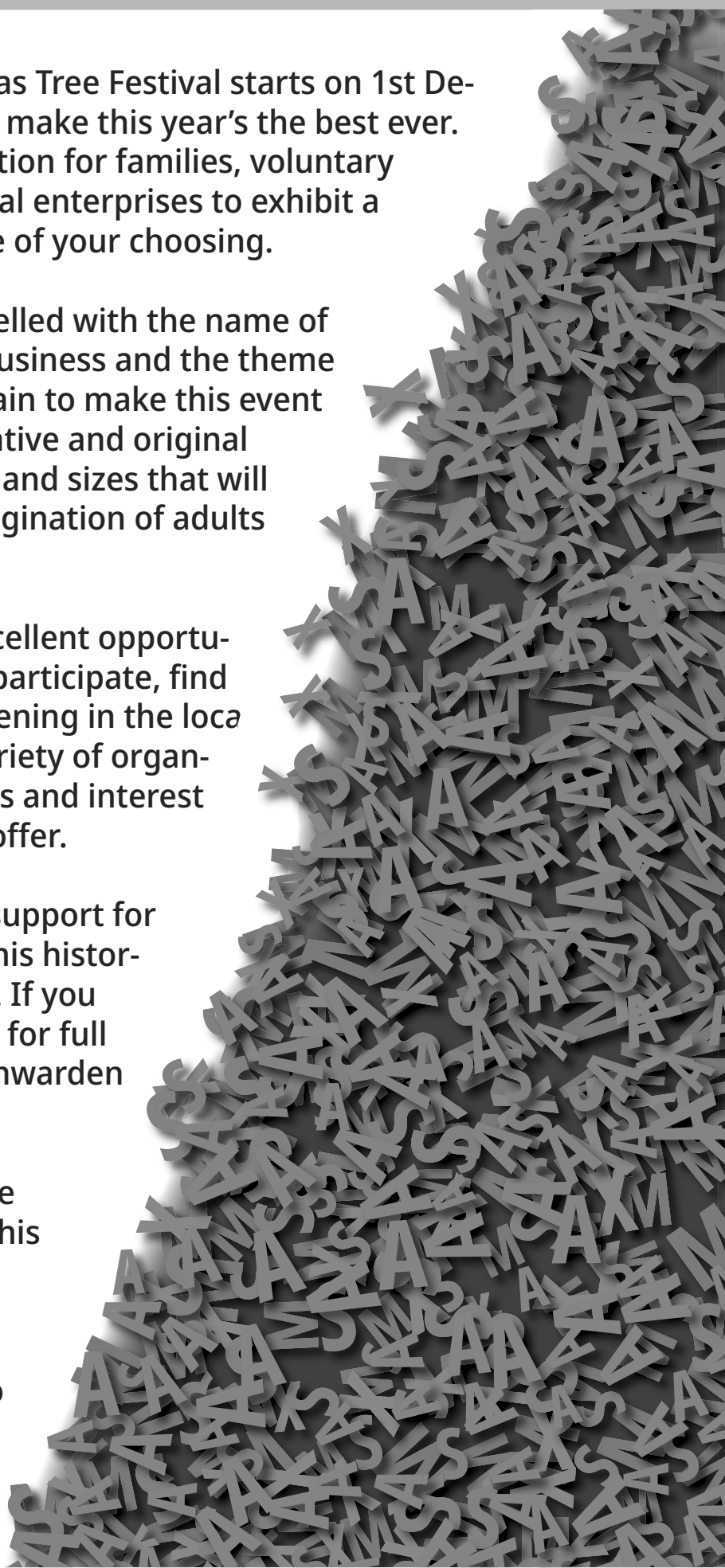

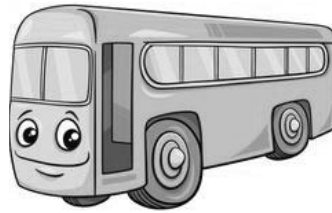

November is quite a significant month in the life of the nation – and in the Church, particularly this year. As you read this we may now be living in post-Brexit Britain, but I suspect that this will make very little difference to some of the events that are planned throughout this month.

The Church's calendar in November begins with All Saints and All Souls. All Saints is the celebration of all the saints of the church – known and unknown, and we shall be celebrating this at our Bradfield St George Service on Sunday 2nd November at 9.30am. It's followed by All Souls Day, which is also known as the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. This is when the Church remembers all who have died – and we often use this opportunity to remember our loved ones.

We will be holding a service for All Souls also on 2nd November at 2pm at Bradfield St Clare, and it will be an opportunity for anyone to come and pray for their relatives and friends. If you would like us to pray for your loved one during the service then please let me know and I can add their name to the list that will be read out at that service. There will also be an opportunity to light a candle for them too.

I couldn't leave the month of November without thinking about Guy Fawkes. It is incredible to think that we are still marking the occasion of the failed gunpowder plot of 1605. We are in a very different society in Britain today to the one inhabited by the gang who were planning to assassinate James I and restore a Catholic monarch to the throne. I discovered that Parliament had passed an act which designated 5 November as a day of thanksgiving for 'the joyful day of deliverance' which remained in force until 1859! I hope you enjoy 5 November, however you celebrate it!

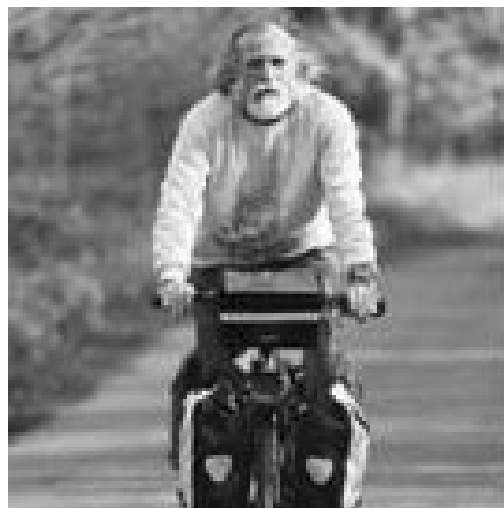

Last month, members were transported to Papua, New Guinea; not a place that many visit. This month saw a tour around the British Isles by Ian Toulson (alias RedSox), our guest speaker, who is a retired teacher from Thurston Community College. His chosen subject, as they say on Mastermind, was **Cycling around Britain's Cathedrals** - a superhuman feat you would think as the list above gives an idea of the places/cathedrals on his list.

His cycling exploits began quite some time ago when he decided to do a ride in memory of a deceased colleague. He was a keen cyclist who had ridden all over the world, so when Walsham le Willows church needed a new organ this plan of cycling to as many cathedrals as possible in a 7 week period to raise funds seemed a good idea.

The winter months were spent plotting the route and arranging where he would stay each night. Luckily he seemed to have a number of relatives and friends scattered in convenient places around the British Isles. Little pamphlets, sponsor forms, crosswords even were printed by Mr.T. (yes printing is another thing he is a dab hand at.)

So 33 cathedrals to be visited, 50 miles per day - 2500 miles in total. We sat spellbound as Mr T proved to be an engaging speaker with many theatrical gestures to accompany each shot of whichever cathedral he was speaking about. Sometimes he photographed the outside only as a) entry charges were high in and/or b) photography was not allowed or only for a fee.

There was many an anecdote on the generosity of individuals such as a complete stranger in Hereford who asked him what he was doing and gave him £20, and about the places that made it all so interesting, so by the end one almost felt inspired to undertake something similar! Until common sense prevailed. The talk ended with a shot of Mr.T.aka Red Sox with his bike in Bury St. Edmunds Cathedral.

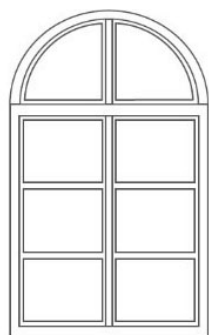

Theft of lead from Hartest Church

Police are appealing for witnesses following the theft of lead from a church in Hartest near Bury St Edmunds.

It took place at some point between Monday 14 and Wednesday 16 October when lead was stolen from the roof of All Saints Church on Lawshall Road.

Officers are urging residents to stay alert to suspicious activity around churches as police have also received a series of around three reports of thefts from offertory boxes in the surrounding area recently, targeting rural churches, situated in remote locations.

Sgt Brian Calver from the Rural Crime team said: "As well as causing a great deal of disruption for the church membership, these crimes are also against our heritage, with no regards for the damage caused or loss of cultural heritage as a result of their actions.

"If you suspect that there are offenders on site, dial 999 as this is a crime in progress and the losses can and do amount to tens of thousands of pounds. Do not approach or disturb the offenders, as by reporting and observing discreetly, it will allow police officers the chance to get to the scene and apprehend those involved."

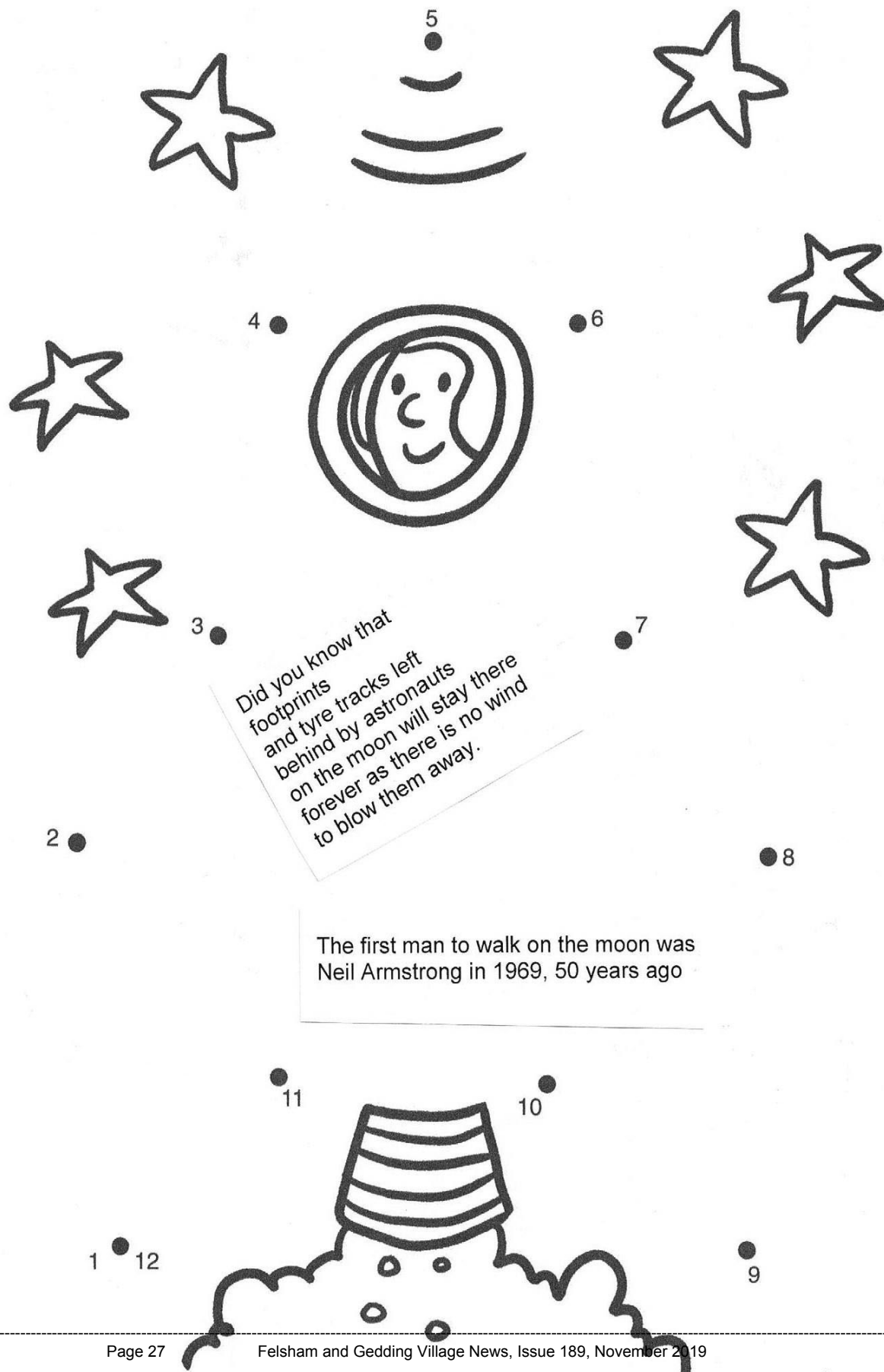
