Please don't feel alone during this Coronavirus crisis

We must all currently (at time of writing) stay at home to help stop the spread of Covid 19 and should only only leave the house for 1 of 4 reasons:

- Shopping for basic necessities, for example food and medicine, which must be as infrequent as possible
- One form of exercise a day, for example a run, walk or cycle alone or with members of your household
- Any medical need, or to provide care or to help a vulnerable person
- Travelling to and from work, but only where this absolutely cannot be done from home

If you are in a high risk group, are at all vulnerable or need to self-isolate please don't feel alone, there are many volunteers within the village who are happy to help you with things such as picking up groceries and prescriptions, walking pets or simply being someone to talk to over the phone.

Pastoral: If you just need a friendly phone call to put your mind at rest or to keep in touch just let us know and we will arrange for someone to call you for a chat.

Unfortunately we do not know everyone who may vulnerable and in this unprecedented time we need to pull together as a community. Please do not hesitate to call if we can help you now or in the coming days/weeks.

Hi All

I don't need to tell any of you how difficult it is to manage through Lockdown. Some are lucky enough to carry on fairly normally and some of us have to Self-Isolate. Government advice is being followed by the Volunteers who are working really hard to keep the shop running.

Social Distancing was a problem in the beginning with the shop and the Post Office in such a small area. Several of our volunteers had already decided that the risk was just too high for them and it was proving very hard to cover all the shifts. I put a shout out for more volunteers and we were not disappointed. Many of you offered your services and we are still getting offers of help, for which the Committee is grateful.

In view of these and other problems (mainly with stock) the Committee made two decisions, which have helped both us and the community:

- 1. To close in the afternoon,
- 2. To start providing a delivery service for the Elderly and Self Isolating.

Our Social Distancing measures are now clearly marked out and explained on notices in and outside of the shop. We ask everyone to please take note of these and follow accordingly. It is 2 metres social distance outside the shop and only one customer at a time in the shop. The volunteer at the door will help with your order while you are waiting if they can.

Bread Orders and Collection: Please collect your bread before 12 noon on the day it is ordered, we have a high demand for fresh bread and very little storage space. If your bread is not collected before noon it will be put out for sale.

Don't forget we are still stocking local produce from Field of Dreams, Lavenham Butchers, Curry with love, Maynards Juices, local Honey, YumYum Tree Fudge and Apple Tree Cottage. We also have a range of gluten free items.

You can place an order at the shop 2 ways: You can call the shop on 01449 736042 from 1pm to 3:30pm. If no one answers leave your name and telephone number on the answer machine and someone will call you back. Or you can email us at: enquires@felshamgeddingstore.org

We have several things going on in the shop: A Teddy Bear Raffle for the NHS; please take part, they are doing a wonderful job and God willing none of us will need their help during this horrid time. Also there's a Quiz; the prize is £20 voucher to spend in the shop. The Quiz has been put together by our lovely Beryl, and is available either in the shop or from Beryl. Why not give it a go? We are asking a minimum donation of £3 - it's just a bit of family fun for lockdown.

Whilst we try to keep the shop stocked with all your needs this is proving difficult for some items. Pasta, hand sanitiser and toilet rolls are now available but tinned items, fruit, fish and veg are in short supply. We are working very hard to find all these items for the shop. Please be patient with us.

Lastly, thank you to the Volunteers who have stepped up and made this work.

Dear Friends

It seems like a long time since we started lockdown and we have had to find other ways to meet together as Church.

It's been a bit of a learning curve but I have learnt how to broadcast services live on Facebook, and started with my first one on Palm Sunday. I was very encouraged by the reception that it had, with a request to sing hymns!

So I did so on Easter Sunday. I have to admit that it was a surreal experience, standing in my dining room singing to my mobile phone, but I know from the comments that I received afterwards that it was very much appreciated. We were able to come together as a community, to share in the celebration of Jesus' resurrection from the dead, sharing in the joy of that Easter morning when Mary discovered that Jesus was alive!

Reading the reports in the news, on websites, and hearing about what is happening across the world has shown us, once again, that the human spirit is amazing. We have seen 99 year olds raising millions of pounds for the NHS. We have seen neighbors making sure that people do not go without food. We have spoken to friends and relatives more often. We have seen incredible bravery, acts of selflessness and pure kindness in many, many people across the breadth and depth of our society.

For me, in all of this, we have encountered the living God, through his Son Jesus Christ, and his Holy Spirit. At times like this we often turn to the Psalms in our bible, as they cover a whole multitude of human emotions, and from which we can draw strength.

Here is one of them which seems to speak to the current pandemic:

'God is our refuge and strength, and ever-present help in trouble.

Therefore we will not fear, though the early give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging'

Psalm 46 v1-3

Whether you believe or don't believe in God, this time that we are living through has also brought many questions to the forefront of our minds. We are thinking about what it really means to live in a 'free' society, where those who are unable to fend for themselves are not always cared for. We are thinking about the effect that humankind has had on the planet which sustains our lives. We are wondering what it truly means to have freedom of choice, and how those choices are in reality dictated by forces that are unseen.

I hope that you have been able to stay safe throughout this crisis, and will continue to do so until such time as we are able to meet together in person once again.

Advice for parents during coronavirus

Whilst coronavirus is infectious to children it is rarely serious. If your child is unwell it is likely to be a non-coronavirus illness, rather than coronavirus itself.

Whilst it is extremely important to follow Government advice to stay at home during this period, it can be confusing to know what to do when your child is unwell or injured. Remember that NHS 111, GPs and hospitals are still providing the same safe care that they have always done. Here is some advice to help:

If your child has any of the following:

- · Becomes pale, mottled and feels abnormally cold to the touch
- Has pauses in their breathing (apnoeas), has an irregular breathing pattern or starts grunting
- · Severe difficulty in breathing becoming agitated or unresponsive
- · Is going blue round the lips
- Has a fit/seizure
- Becomes extremely distressed (crying inconsolably despite distraction), confused, very lethargic (difficult to wake) or unresponsive
- Develops a rash that does not disappear with pressure (the 'Glass test')
- · Has testicular pain, especially in teenage boys

You need urgent help:

Go to the nearest A&E department or phone 999



AMBER

If your child has any of the following:

- Is finding it hard to breathe including drawing in of the muscles below their lower ribs, at their neck or between their ribs (recession) or head bobbing
- Seems dehydrated (dry mouth, sunken eyes, no tears, drowsy or passing less urine than usual)
- Is becoming drowsy (excessively sleepy) or irritable (unable to settle them with toys, TV, food or picking up) - especially if they remain drowsy or irritable despite their fever coming down
- · Has extreme shivering or complains of muscle pain
- Babies under 3 months of age with a temperature above 38°C / 100 d°F
- Infants 3-6 months of age with a temperature above 39°C I 102.2°E
- For all infants and children with a fever above 38°C for more than 5 days.
- · Is getting worse or if you are worried
- · Has persistent vomiting and/or persistent severe abdominal pain
- · Has blood in their poo or wee
- Any limb injury causing reduced movement, persistent pain or head injury causing persistent crying or drowsiness

You need to contact a doctor or nurse today.

Please ring your GP surgery or call NHS 111 - dial 111

The NHS is working for you. However, we recognise during the current coronavirus crisis at peak times, access to a health care professional may be delayed. If symptoms persist for 4 hours or more and you have not been able to speak to either a GP or 111, then take your child to the nearest A&E

- You can continue to provide your child care at home. Information is also available on NHS Choices

Mix dry ingredients Add the beer and stir in Scrape mixture into a small loaf tin Sprinkle on your choice of topping

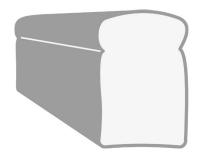

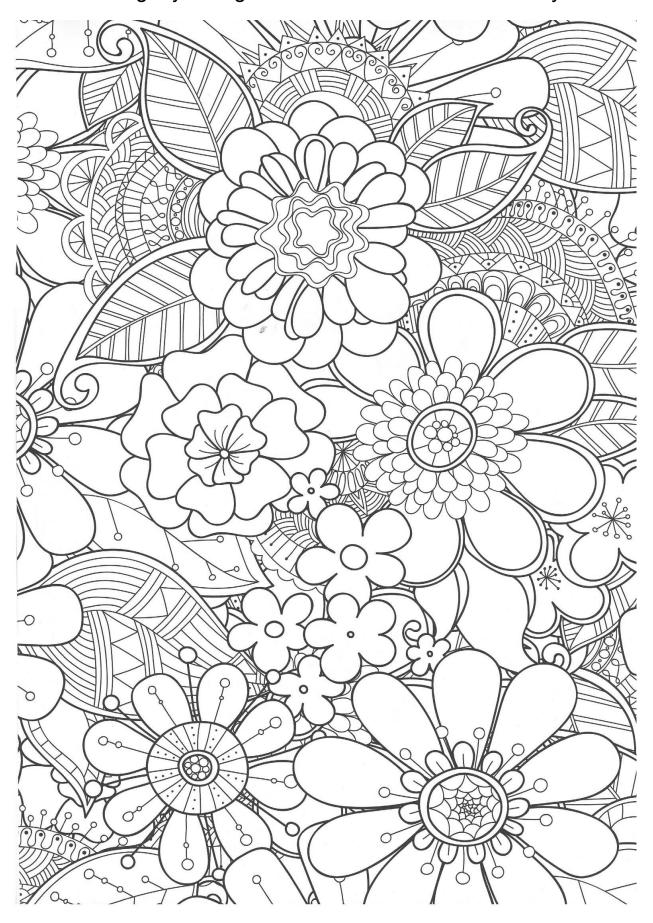
