Christmas comes early for Stowmarket choir

Stowmarket Chorale, a 65-member choral society with a 120-year history of putting on concerts in Stowmarket and beyond, received a nice present just before Christmas. Stowmarket Town Council approved a grant of £500 towards helping the choir get through this difficult time when in-person concerts, and even rehearsals, have been impossible to provide.

The choir is still meeting on Wednesday nights at 7.30pm, but instead of being at Combs Ford Primary School the rehearsal is held online, on the Zoom platform. The choir has had to adapt its choice of rehearsal music since the Covid crisis struck, and has now offered so far a wide assortment of material to keep members interested – from the soaring harmonies of sacred favourites such as Mozart's Ave Verum Corpus, to the evergreen tunefulness of A Nightingale Sang in Berkeley Square. In the run up to this most peculiar Christmas, participants were invited to put in requests for favourite carols to sing.

It was decided to make the sessions open to the public - guest singers are allowed to participate without charge and without commitment, and are warmly welcomed. 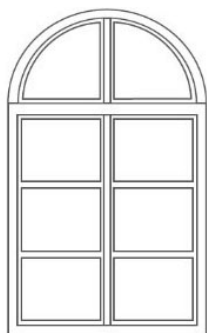

The Cockfield Benefice

Dear Friends,

We are in the midst of a not-quite-yet-out-of-pandemic time. Some of us have had a vaccine, others are still shielding, some are suffering with the virus, and the rest of us are doing the best we can to live our lives within the constraints that have had to be imposed on society. So what is there to celebrate this month? For me personally on 20th February it's the 9th anniversary of my induction here as Rector. I cannot believe that it's been 9 years, how time flies!

Being Rector here is certainly one of the best things that I have ever been called to in my life as a Christian. Life is very varied, and there's always something in the diary to look forward to! Well, there was until Covid struck.

One of the things that has happened recently via the technology of video conferencing is that those who serve the governance of the church in the villages of Felsham and Gedding i.e. the Parochial Church Council (or PCC as it's known, not to be mistaken for the Parish Council!) and its officers, have made the decision to join together to form one PCC rather than having two separate PCCs.

I guess you will be wondering what on earth that really means? Well it means that by joining together the two PCCs into one lots of things can be shared; expertise, support, roles and responsibilities. This does not mean that only one church will be used, as with this scheme both Felsham and Gedding Church will retain their parish church status. This means that Sunday services, baptisms, funerals and weddings carry on as normal. It just means that there will be less meetings for those who are on the PCC, and everyone can work together in the mission and ministry of both churches.

If you have any questions about this don't hesitate to contact me, my door is always open (of course at the moment it's my phone, email or messaging via facebook!). I do hope that you stay safe, and are able to catch up with our weekly service that is broadcast via our facebook page every Sunday at 10am.

We are hearing reports across the Country of people being contacted out of the blue with offers of a coronavirus vaccination. Reports have been of a text message that purports to be from the NHS, which contains a link that takes you to a website that looks very similar in design to that of the genuine NHS website. The website is bogus, and asks you to provide a banking card to make a payment.

There have also been reports of elderly residents receiving a call to advise their vaccination would be carried out at home, and the caller required their name, address and also financial details to pay for the vaccine.

Other reports relate to a recorded voice message on the telephone and the recipient is required to respond by pressing 1 when receiving the call. They are then asked to give personal information, as well as financial details to book their vaccination.

THESE ARE SCAMS.

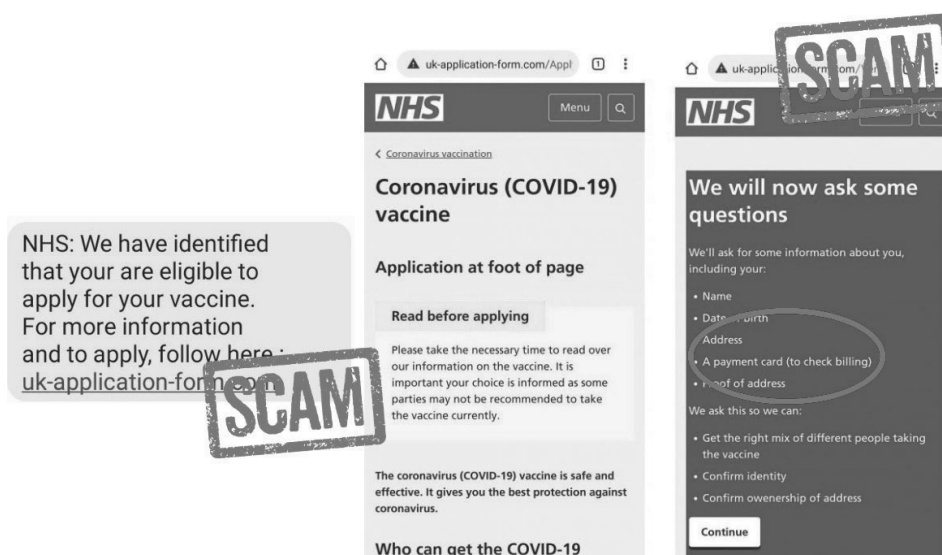
Criminals are exploiting the current situation to attempt to steal personal details and your money. The NHS is currently offering the COVID-19 vaccine to people most at risk from coronavirus. These people will be contacted by the NHS.

NO PAYMENT IS REQUIRED FOR THE VACCINE.

There has been a surge worldwide of vaccine related phishing email scams. We expect to see an increase in these. Some contain malicious files that install malware, or links to bogus websites to obtain the victim's information.

Protect yourself by checking the email addresses on incoming messages, and be alert to hyperlinks containing misspelled domain names; be aware of highly emotive language designed to manipulate you; do not supply login credentials or personal information in response to an email; monitor key financial accounts regularly; and keep software and apps updated.

Meatball Black Bean Chilli

Serves 4

Ingredients: 2 *tblsp olive oil*
 12 *beef meatballs*
 1 *onion, finely sliced*
 2 *mixed peppers, sliced*
 ½ *large bunch coriander, leaves and stalks chopped*
 2 *large garlic cloves, crushed*
 1 *tsp hot smoked paprika*
 2 *tsp ground cumin*
 1 *heaped tblsp light brown soft sugar*
 2 x 400g *cans chopped tomatoes*
 2 x 400g *cans black beans, drained and rinsed*

cooked rice, to serve

STEP 1

Heat the oil in a large flameproof casserole dish over a medium heat. Fry the meatballs for 5 mins until browned, then transfer to a plate with a slotted spoon.

STEP 2

Fry the onion and peppers with a pinch of salt for 7 mins. Add the coriander stalks, garlic, paprika and cumin and fry for 1 min more. Tip in the sugar, tomatoes and beans, and bring to a simmer. Season, return the meatballs to the pan and cook, covered, for 15 mins. To freeze, leave to cool completely and transfer to large freezerproof bags.

STEP 3

Serve the chilli with the rice and the coriander leaves scattered over.
