2019/2563	Declarations of Interest and requests for dispensation – None
2019/2564	Minutes of Parish Council Meeting – It was proposed by Cllr Williams that the
2013/2301	minutes of the previous Parish Council Meeting were approved with all in favour. The
	Parish Council Meeting minutes of 18th June 2019 were signed as a true record.
2019/2565	County & District Councillor Otton – Cllr Otton gave her report, which had been
2019/2303	circulated, and is attached to these minutes. Discussion took place regarding the loss of
	village bus services with a suggestion that numbers of users be surveyed.
2019/2566	Public Participation – No questions
2019/2567	Clerks Report - It has been confirmed by SALC that the current councillor vacancy does
2019/2307	not have to be notified to MSDC therefore co option can take place at any time going
	forward. Two people who have expressed an interest will be contacted before further
	advertising is carried out.
	Joint Local Plan - draft is out for consultation, all councillors encouraged to read it and
	consider any effects on Felsham before a response is drafted for submission.
	It was agreed that the clerk will try to establish an update on the replacement of post
	boxes.
2019/2568	Planning – There were no MSDC application to consider.
2019/2569	The following MSDC decisions were noted - DC/19/02775 Notification of Works to Trees
	in a Conservation Area - T1 (Sycamore) - Thin out regrowth by 50% and to reduce the
	overall height by 30%, Lower Green Barn, Lower Green - NO WISH TO OBJECT
2019/2570	Finance – The Finance Report for July 2019 was approved.
2019/2571	The following payments were approved. Prop by Cllr Williams, with all in favour. Clerks

2019/2573	Correspondence – Green Access Strategy Consultation closes 20th Sept. Consideration
	of a response to this will be added to the next agenda.
2019/2574	There were no comments to any tabled correspondence.
2019/2575	Village Maintenance – Tree Officer Report – Cllr Tavernor reported that people should
	be on the lookout for Oak Moth which has been imported into the UK on medium sized
	trees. There are no suspect trees known of in the village.
2019/2576	Council have received a further request from a resident for some form of marking to
	acknowledge the Oak Tree on Lower Green as a memorial. It is believed that the Oak
	Tree is one donated by the Butcher Family and it was agreed that some form of plaque or
	certificate could be sited at the village hall to commemorate this. It was confirmed that a
	plaque on the tree or at Lower Green would not be possible.
2019/2577	Concern was expressed that grass verges in the village had not yet been cut and areas
	along Bury Rd and into Gedding were especially dangerous for pedestrians. It was
	confirmed that Felsham was on the cutting schedule for late July so this issue would
	hopefully be addressed in the next couple of weeks. It was suggested that if in future an
	earlier cut was preferred that this would need to be sourced via volunteers, local
	landowners would be asked if this was something they may be willing to help with,
2010/2	further consideration of additional verge cutting would be added to the next agenda.
2019/2578	Concern was expressed regarding the many potholes around Upper Green, these would
2012/2552	be reported once photos were available.
2019/2579	There were no further maintenance matters reported.

2019/2580 2019/2581	Conservation Area – Conservation Officer Report – No report. There were no further Conservation matters reported.
2019/2582	Footpaths – Footpath Officer Report – Cllr Nunn reported that the waymarker for FP 8 was missing and that no update on the issues with FP8 had been received. The clerk will seek clarification from ROW on progress with this dispute.
2019/2583	It was noted that FP13 had again not been included in the scheduled cutting. This will be reported.
2019/2584	It was suggested that a proper review of footpaths be undertaken with copies of the definitive map made available. Confirmation of the route of the churchyard paths was needed now that vegetation clearing had taken place before any waymarking is installed. Consideration of a review will be added to an August meeting agenda.
2019/2585	There were no further Footpath matters reported.
2019/2586	Local Housing Survey - It was agreed that a Working Group be established to progress the schedule and advertising of the Questionnaire. Further consideration deferred to next meeting.
2019/2587	Village Sign - Decisions regarding the design and costings were deferred to the next meeting.
2019/2588	Matters to be brought to the attention of council – It was agreed that an additional meeting during August be called to consider a response to the Joint Local Plan and to action a Footpath review.
